

ALLY TIPS

- 1. Listen, listen, listen.
- 2. Avoid assumptions.
- 3. Educate yourself and others.
- 4. Model inclusive language.
- 5. Remember that identity development is a process.
- 6. Speak up, but not over.
- Know when to keep it private.
- 8. Understand that diverse identities affect people's lived experiences differently.
- 9. Work to bring awareness and understanding to less visible identities.
- 10. Apologize when you make mistakes.
